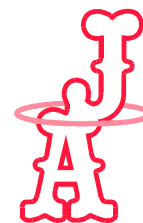

News from the Top

It was another good year for our golf outing "Angels in the Fairway". Our numbers were slightly down from past years, but they were still very good considering the economy the last three years. We had close to 500 golfers participate at the three courses, and about the same attended our dinner program. We were able to raise about \$105,000 with just over \$23,000 raised on that day alone. Our seven year total is now over \$850,000 raised for the Foundation in Joey's name. It is finally starting to sink in just how much money we've raised for our cause. I can't thank everyone enough for their efforts, hard work, and continued support.



Well, as mentioned at the outing, next year's "Angels in the Fairway" will be held in **Lake Geneva, Wisconsin**. We have already met with the people at the Grand Geneva Resort several times and have locked in our event at their facility. It will be **Friday, August 6, 2004**. They have two beautiful courses that we will utilize for the double shotguns, The Brute and The Highlands.
