## Joey's Angels/LRF Win \$25,000 from Sprint/Nextel Contest!

The charity receiving the most votes at the end of the contest in their respected markets won \$25,000! Sprint/Nextel held this contest in 20 different markets in the US donating over \$500,000 to local charities nationwide. "The Joey's Angels Chapter of the Leukemia Research Foundation has raised in excess of \$1.2 million in support of the LRF's mission during the last decade," said Kevin Radelet, Executive Director of the LRF. "The entire Foundation is honored that Sprint/Nextel shares our commitment to finding a cure. Obviously Sprint/Nextel has tremendous respect for the efforts of all the volunteers and supporters of Joey's Angels and we're truly grateful for this significant contribution to the cause."
