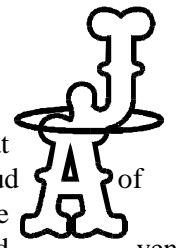
July 27, 2002 - Dan Barton Motorcycle and Car Rally

Judy's Jaunts

Judy Mullen, Joey's Aunt (Patty's sister), is an avid music fan. She calls herself a Rebel with a Heart. She has been on a quest to get unique musical items for the golf outing's raffle and silent auction – here is an update of her endeavors:

In **August 2001**, Judy went to see BB King, John Hiatt, and Sonny Landreth on their blues tour at the Rosemont Theater. She decided to donate her own Ibanez Concord acoustic guitar and try to get it signed. At the concert in August, Sonny Landreth (one of the world's best slide players, signed the guitar. The same night backstage, John Hiatt signed the guitar and during the same evening, she met the living legend BB King.

Now, BB King has a contract with Gibson Guitars so he could not sign the Ibanez, however, she showed him Joey's photo and explained Joey's Angels to him and he signed two JA hats and gave her a signed picture of himself for an auction item.

In **October 2001**, Judy drove down to Bloomington, Indiana to the "Mellenbash", John Mellencamp's 50th birthday party put together by his fans. She was hoping to meet John Mellencamp in person but he was not there. She did meet Moe Z. MD, who plays keyboards, percussion, and sings background vocals, and is a member of John Mellencamp's band. He is also featured on several of his CDs. He signed the guitar, along with a photo of him and John while on the Cuttin' Heads Tour 2001. John Gunnell also known as "Jon E Gee" who is John's bass player also signed the guitar. Toby Meyers, who was with John Mellencamp on bass guitar and vocals till 1998 was also there and he signed the guitar.

In **November 2001**, Judy mailed another "Joey's Angels" package to a man who knows John Mellencamp in hopes of getting the guitar signed. Michael Angelo, who is one of the world's fastest guitar players, brought the guitar back to Bloomington, IN and gave it to a man who is part of the management team that works with John Mellencamp. The guitar was hand delivered to John Mellencamp's house where he signed it in December. Michael Angelo also signed the guitar and returned it to Judy.
