Our 6th Annual Angels in the Fairway golf outing was again a huge success. We probably had our best day of weather in our six years. It was perfect for golf and our many volunteers. We were again sold out for the 6th consecutive year with a combined 520 golfers attending our three shotguns held at Midlane and ThunderHawk. We had close to 575 golfer and guests attend our dinner program that night at Midlane and again, for the sixth year in a row, we raised \$30,000 on that day alone, with a total of \$120,000 for the outing itself. Our six-year total now stands at nearly \$750,000 raised for the Foundation in Joey's memory.
